The regular business meeting of the Town of Rogersville Board of Mayor and Aldermen was held Tuesday, January 9, 2018, at 7:00 p.m. in the Boardroom at City Hall. All members present.

Motion by Bill Henderson second by Eloise Edwards to accept the minutes as presented. All voted Aye.

Mayor Jim Sells asked if anyone not on the agenda had something to bring before the Board. No comments.

Motion by Brian Hartness second by Bill Henderson to pass **Ordinance 12-12-17-1**, which rezones property located at 151 Marion Street from R-2 (Medium Density) Residential to B-3 (Intermediate Business) District. **Second Reading**. All voted Aye.

Public Hearing: Ordinance 12-12-17-1 rezoning property located at 151 Marion Street from R-2 (Medium Density) Residential to B-3 (Intermediate Business) District. No comments.
